University Regulation on University of Aizu International Students

April 1, 2006, Regulation No. 73

Article One (Objective)

1.1 This regulation provides for necessary matters concerning International Students prescribed under Article 43 of the Ruling on the University of Aizu and Article 43 of the Ruling on the University of Aizu Graduate School.

Article Two

(Classification)

- 2.1 The classifications of International Students shall be as follows:
- (1) General University Students;
- (2) Non-degree Students;
- (3) Research Students; and
- (4) Special Audit Students.

Article Three

(Admissions Qualifications)

3.1 Individuals qualified to be admitted to the Undergraduate School as International Students shall be individuals not possessing Japanese nationality (excluding individuals having graduated from a Japanese high school or recognized as possessing academic ability equal thereto or greater) and corresponding to the respective individual in the following table.

Special Audit Students	Individuals enrolled at overseas universities or junior colleges with which the mutual exchange of academic credit is recognized, with such recognition based upon consultation with the University.

3.2 Individuals qualified to be admitted to the Graduate School as International Students shall be individuals not possessing Japanese nationality (excluding individuals having graduated from a Japanese university or recognized as possessing academic ability equal thereto or greater) and corresponding to the respective individual in the following table.

Special Audit Students	Individuals enrolled at overseas gradate schools with which the mutual exchange of academic credit is recognized, with such recognition based upon consultation with the University.

Article Four (Admissions Period)

4.1 International Student admissions shall be that period provided for each of the classifications under Article 2 herein.

Article Five (Admissions Application Procedure)

- 5.1 Individuals applying for admission as International Students shall attach a copy of their family register or residence certificate issued by the official entity of their country of citizenship and any other documents to an admissions application and shall submit these items to the University President.
- 5.2 Individuals applying for admissions as general university students, Non-degree Students, and Research Students must pay an application fee.

6.1 With respect to the admissions candidates referred to in Article 5 above, selection shall be conducted as provided separately.

Article Seven (Admissions Procedure)

7.1 The University President shall conduct the notification to the successful admissions candidates provided for in Article 6 above.

- 7.2 Individuals that have received the notification provided for in Paragraph 7.1 above must submit the prescribed documents by the prescribed date and, except for Special Audit Students, pay an admission fee in addition.
- 7.3 The University President shall approve the admission of those individuals who have completed the procedures provided for in Paragraph 7.2 above.

Article Eight

(Establishment Of Japanese Language Courses And Courses Concerning Japanese Matters)

- 8.1 In situations in which International Students are admitted, Japanese language courses and courses concerning Japanese matters (for the purpose of this regulation, hereinafter referred to as "JAPANESE COURSES, ETC.") can be established.
- 8.2 Of those International Students having completed the JAPANESE COURSES, ETC. provided for in Paragraph 8.1 above, general university students, Non-degree Students, and Special Audit Students can be awarded the respective prescribed University academic credit.

Article Nine (Tuition Etc.)

9.1 International Students must pay the tuition corresponding to their classification during the enrollment period.

Article Ten (Nationally Sponsored International Students)

10.1 International students under the Nationally Sponsored International Student System - notwithstanding the provisions of Paragraphs 5.2 and 7.2 and Article 9 above - shall not be charged an application fee, admission fee, and tuition.

Article Eleven
(Application Of The Regulation, Etc.)

11.1 Other than provided for by this regulation, matters concerning students within the University rules and various regulations shall apply correspondingly to International Students.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

This regulation shall be enforced as of April 1, 2006.
