

Regulation Concerning the University of Aizu Fixed Asset Usage Fees

Regulation No. 6 April 1, 2006

Article One

(Collection of Usage Fees)

1.1 The Public University Corporation, the University of Aizu (hereinafter referred to as “UNIVERSITY”) shall collect fees for use of UNIVERSITY facilities, for the use of services provided through equipment, etc. installed in UNIVERSITY facilities, or for the installation of objects in UNIVERSITY premises or buildings, in accordance with the provisions provided for in this regulation.

Article Two

(Usage Fees for the Auditorium, Lecture Theater, and Regular Lecture Rooms)

2.1 Fees for use of the Auditorium, Lecture Theater, and regular lecture rooms shall be in accordance with attached table 1-1. However, in cases where Fukushima Prefecture-affiliated organizations or other public organizations use the Auditorium, Lecture Theater, or regular lecture rooms, usage fees shall be in accordance with attached table 1-2.

2.2 The Chairperson of the Board of Executives, in cases where use described in paragraph 2.1 above are applicable to reduction or exemption of the usage fees specified in attached table 1-3, may reduce relevant fees or exempt users from usage fees not exceeding the range for reduction or exemption provided for in attached table 1-3.

Article Three

(Usage Fees for the University-Business Innovation Center)

3.1 Fees for use of the University-Business Innovation Center shall be in accordance with attached table 2-1.

3.2 The Chairperson of the Board of Executives, in cases where use described in paragraph 3.1 above are applicable to reduction of relevant fees or exemption of the usage fees specified in attached table 2-2, may reduce relevant fees or exempt users from usage fees not exceeding the range for reduction or exemption provided for in attached table 2-2.

Article Four

(Usage Fees for Sports Facilities)

4.1 Fees for use of the gymnasium, swimming pool, martial arts hall, tennis courts and athletic field shall be in accordance with the provisions provided for in attached table 3-1. However, in cases where Fukushima Prefecture-affiliated organizations or other public organizations use aforementioned sports facilities for the purposes of cultural or physical activities, usage fees shall be in accordance with attached table 3-2.

4.2 The Chairperson of the Board of Executives, in cases where use described in paragraph 4.1 above is applicable to reduction or exemption of the usage fees specified in attached table 3-3, may reduce relevant fees or exempt users from usage fees not exceeding the range for reduction or exemption provided for in attached table 3-3.

Article Five

(Fees for Installation of Objects)

5.1 Fees for installation of objects within the UNIVERSITY's premises or buildings shall be in accordance with the provisions provided for in attached table 4-1.

5.2 The Chairperson of the Board of Executives, in cases where installation described in paragraph 5.1 above are applicable to reduction or exemption of the fees specified in attached table 4-2, may reduce relevant fees or exempt parties installing objects from fees not exceeding the range for reduction or exemption provided for in attached table 4-2.

Article Six

(Usage Fees of the Laboratory for Leading-edge ICT in Aizu (LICTiA))

6.1 Usage fees of the LICTiA shall be in accordance with the attached tables 5-1 and 5-2.

6.2 The Chairperson of the Board of Executives, in cases where use described in paragraph 6.1 above is applicable to the reduction or exemption of usage fees specified in attached table 5-3, may reduce relevant fees or exempt users from usage fees not exceeding the range for reduction or exemption provided for in attached table 5-3.

Article Seven

(Methods for Payment of Usage Fees)

7.1 Usage fees must be paid to a specified bank account by the payment deadline designated on the invoice. However, these fees may be paid in cash on the day of use only if the day of use is a regular weekday.

7.2 Other than the payment methods provided for in paragraph 6.1 above, payments of usage fees shall follow the Regulation concerning Income of the University of Aizu.

Article Eight

(Non-refund of Usage Fees)

8.1 Usage fees paid to the UNIVERSITY shall not be refunded. However, this provision shall not apply to cases where users cannot be held liable for unavailability of relevant facilities.

Article Nine

(Entrustment)

9.1 Other than those provided for in this regulation, necessary matters concerning usage fees shall be determined separately by the Chairperson of the Board of Executives.

1. This regulation shall be enforced as of April 1, 2006.

2. The provisions of the revised version of Attached Table 3-3 of the Regulation Concerning the University of Aizu Fixed Asset Usage Fees shall apply to usage fees for use occurring on or after April 1, 2017.

1. This regulation shall be enforced as of October 1, 2017.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

1. This regulation shall be enforced as of October 1, 2019.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

1. This regulation shall be enforced as of June 1, 2023.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

1. This regulation shall be enforced as of April 1, 2024.

2. Periods shorter than one year which are included in a requested period of use shall be counted on a monthly basis, and periods shorter than one month shall be rounded up to one month.

3. If a requested period of use is shorter than basic periods of use correspondingly provided for in the table above, relevant period shall be regarded as the basic period of use for determination of usage fees. However, for incubation space (membership), the above amount shall be multiplied by one-half for periods of use of less than two weeks.

4. Amounts smaller than 10 yen shall be rounded down.

5. In case of shared use of a Research and Development Room by two tenants, the usage fee of the room per year for each tenant shall be half of the fee mentioned above.
